These books will focus on important topics such as consent, bodily autonomy, gender, and related age-appropriate themes.

Key Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Project & Research Coordinator and the A.N.B.U. team to understand the themes and messages of each book.
- Create original, high-quality illustrations that are visually appealing and suitable for children.
- Develop characters, backgrounds, and other visual elements that enhance the storytelling.
- Ensure that the illustrations are age-appropriate, trauma-informed, and sensitive to the themes of consent, bodily autonomy, and gender.
- Revise and edit illustrations based on feedback from the team to ensure they meet project requirements.
- Work within project timelines to ensure timely delivery of illustrations.

- Proven experience as a Graphic Designer and/or Illustrator, preferably with a focus on children's books or educational materials.
- Strong portfolio showcasing your illustration skills and creative process.

- Ability to create illustrations that are engaging, educational, and sensitive to young audiences.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.
